## SMOKING POLICY

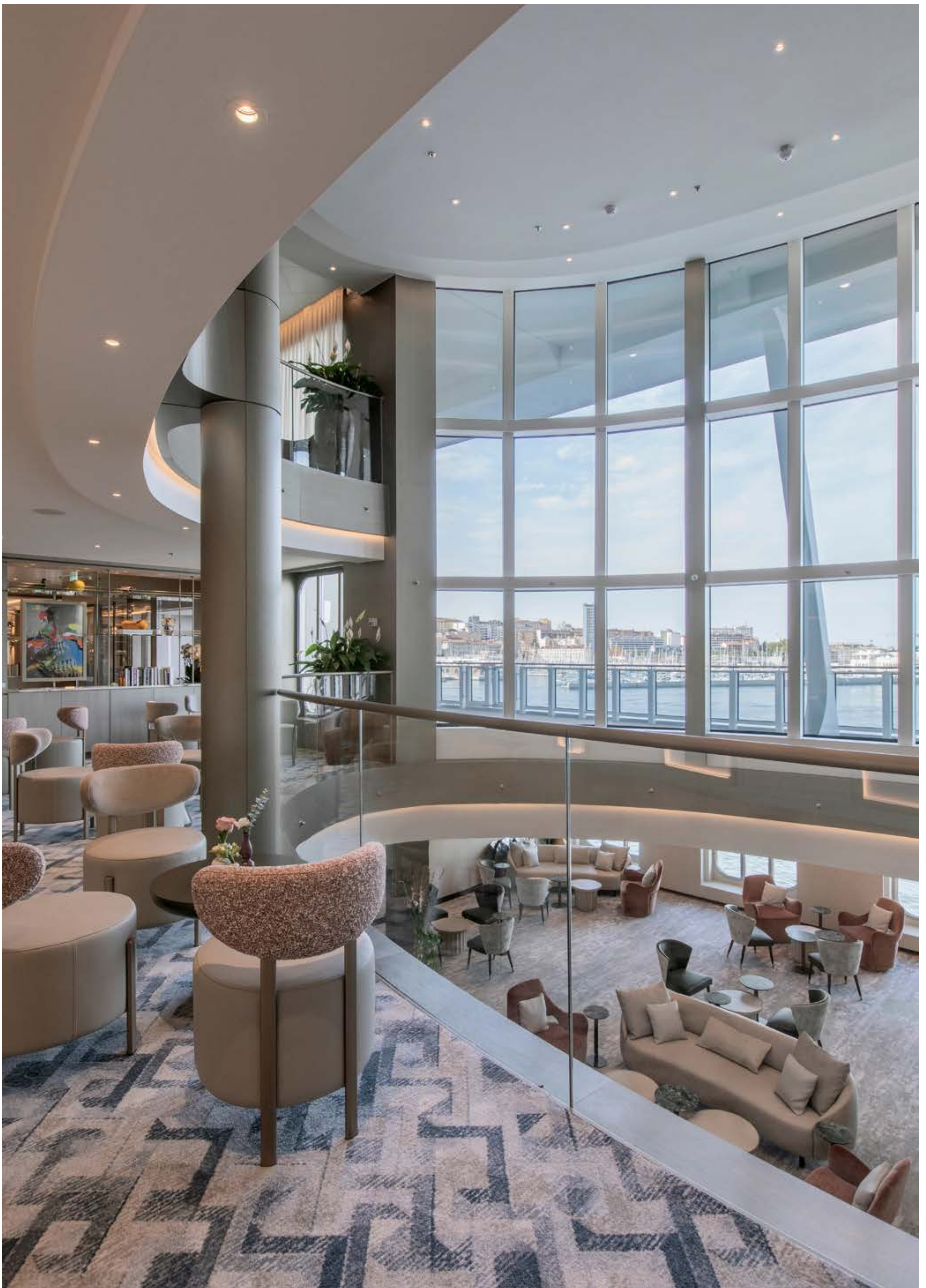

# Dress code



Silversea operates an onboard dress code after 6:00 pm. During the day, casual wear is suitable, akin to standard sports outfits found at five-star resorts. It is recommended to wear flat or low-heeled shoes for deck activities. Evening wear falls into two categories:

## **ELEGANT CASUAL**

On casual evenings, ladies may opt for trousers, blouses, skirts, or casual dresses, while gentlemen can wear open-collar shirts and slacks. A jacket is optional.

## **FORMAL OPTIONAL**

Guests may choose a more formal attire, such as an evening gown or cocktail dress for ladies and a tuxedo, dinner jacket, or dark suit with a tie for gentlemen. Alternatively, guests are welcome to adhere to the Elegant Casual dress code, except that gentlemen must wear a jacket in all indoor spaces.

Regardless of the daily dress code:

- After 6:00 pm, indoor spaces prohibit jeans, shorts, sneakers, or flip flop-type footwear.
- Casual wear is always suitable in outdoor venues.
- Gentlemen dining at La Dame restaurant are required to wear a jacket.

A signature twist on the Brandy Alexander, it relies on local spirits for a uniquely Italian drink. Cocchi Americano is an atomized aperitif wine made with aromatic herbs and spice infusions while Nonino Grappa is a grappa brand obtained from the fresh and soft pomace of white and red grapes, imparting a crisp, fragrant flavor. Serravinci Pistacchino is a bright green and creamy pistachio liqueur that brings its distinctive nutty flavor to the forefront

The result is a rich, indulgent, luxurious serve for those with a sweet tooth. *Â saluti!*

**INGREDIENTS:**

3/4 oz. cream  
3/4 oz. Cocchi Americano aperitif wine  
3/4 oz. Nonino Grappa  
3/4 oz. Serravinci Pistacchino liqueur

**FOR SPICED PISTACHIO DUST:**

1 bsp. mixed spice powder  
1 oz. brown sugar  
1 oz. desiccated coconut  
2 oz. pistachio kernels

**HOW TO PREPARE:**

Collect a cocktail shaker and add all of the ingredients.  
Add Top with cubed ice and shake for 10 seconds.  
Fine strain into another cocktail shaker and shake for 10 seconds without ice.  
Pour into glass, add 3 dashes of Peychaud's Bitters into the foam.  
Express the lemon zest over the cocktail and discard.

## **JOHNNY CAKES: A BREAD ON A JOURNEY**

Johnny Cakes are a staple food made throughout the Caribbean, a fried bread that can be eaten on its own or alongside a meal. Some say they were originally called "journey cakes," as these biscuits have been known to last for weeks on long sea voyages, and via different accents in the region the name evolved into the Johnny cakes we know today. In the Caribbean, the cornmeal is usually replaced by wheat flour, and the 'cakes' are eaten with butter and marmalade, or used to make breakfast sandwiches filled with ham and cheese.

Recipes include: Johnny Cakes, Saltfish Hash

## **MEXICAN COMFORT FOOD: COCINAS ECONOMICAS**

If you have wondered what people eat at home every day in Mexico, a visit to a "Cocina Económica," or an informal restaurant with an emphasis on home cooking, will satisfy your curiosity. The name translates to "inexpensive kitchen" and this is Latin America's version of the corner diner, the neighborhood café, or the local deli, and is often run by women who serve food from the front room of their family's home.

The cuisine featured in Cocinas Economicas around Yucatan is a wonderful way to sample the range of local speciality dishes the way the locals prepare and eat them. More than just a meal, the cuisine of Cocinas Economicas is an exploration of culture and family in Modern Mexico.

Recipes included: Albondigas de Pavo and Arroz Blanco

## **TASTES OF THE GARIFUNA KITCHEN**

The real food of the Caribbean is far from the homogenous offerings often found in resort buffets. Take the Garifuna people whose culinary traditions are as distinct and compelling as their native tongue and arts, recognized by UNESCO as a "Masterpiece of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity." Descended from enslaved West Africans who were shipwrecked or escaped and found their way to the Caribbean and eventually intermarried with local populations, the Garifuna are now spread between Belize, Guatemala, Nicaragua, and Honduras. Garifuna cooking draws on local ingredients as well as African traditions. Hudutu, a staple fish and coconut stew, is traditionally made by Garifuna women, with men pitching in to mash the plantains. We'll discover this dish and other gems of the Garifuna kitchen and come away with a deeper appreciation for the complex history and vibrant culture of the people of this beautiful region.

Recipes include: Hudutu, traditional fish stew with mashed plantains

### **CUISINE AT THE CROSSROADS: FOODS OF PANAMA**

The cuisine of Panama is a fascinating blend of Spanish, French, Chinese and Afro-Caribbean influence, embracing the indigenous recipes of groups like the Guna Yala and Ngöbe-Buglé peoples. As the story goes, 'Panamá', meaning 'abundance of fish', was the indigenous name of a small fishermen village; five centuries later, it is a place where shrimp wontons can be found in the corner bodega and a fried snapper might be served with a hint of curry.

Recipes include: Ceviche de Corvina (seabass) and red snapper Pargo Rojo al Escabeche

### **WORLD IN A CUP: HISTORY AND CULTURE OF COFFEE IN LATIN AMERICA**

The unlikely true tale of how the coffee bean arrived on the continent in the 15th century and went on to become an essential export and key crop. Drink in the history and culture of the world's biggest producer of coffee.

### **HAUTE POCKETS: EMPANADAS**

Explore the world of empanadas, the half-moon shaped pastry-wrapped pies. With a dough that can be made from corn, flour or plantains, and fillings that range from gooey cheese to shredded beef to dessert versions filled with tart fruit and dulce de leche, the varieties are as limitless as the love for them across Central and South America.

Recipes include: Shrimp-filled Morocho Empanadas and Empanadas de Viento, a sweet cheese-filled variety.

### **PERU'S CARAPULCRA: A DISH FULL OF STORIES**

Peru is home to many cuisines and its most celebrated dishes bear witness to centuries of migration and intermingling of cultures. Take Carapulcra for example: One of the oldest and most storied of Peru's traditional dishes, it is a stew of pork or chicken, dried potatoes, peanuts and chili peppers that tells the story of Andean, Incan, Creole, Italian and Afro-Peruvian influences on the fascinating, multi-ethnic foodways of this country.

Recipes include: Carapulcra stew and Sopa Seca
